Tish Berlin teaches in California and at workshops around the country, including the Amherst Early Music Festival and the Oregon Coast Recorder Society Winds and Waves workshop. She directs the Hidden Valley Early Music Road Scholar workshop, the San Francisco Early Music Society Music Discovery Workshop and several small workshops for Tibia Adventures in Music. Besides Farallon, Ms. Berlin performs with the Bertamo Trio, Calextone and the Sitka Trio. Ms. Berlin has performed with the San Francisco Symphony, the Carmel Bach Festival, the North Carolina Baroque Orchestra and the Atlanta Baroque Orchestra.

Mehrdad Teymoori is a music instructor and conductor in Tehran, Iran. Since 2007 he has conducted an orchestra of the advanced recorder students, percussion, and singers.
