Class Topics

Articulation - technique and application in music
Finger facility - exercises and drills to improve security and agility
Breathing and Blowing - development of breath control and tone
Sight reading and playing by ear - methods and exercises to improve your skills
Keeping Your Place and Rhythm Training - repertoire chosen to fully incorporate these skills into your playing
Consort repertoire and ad hoc playing sessions
Lecture/discussions on music history and musical forms

Workshop Location

The Next Level Recorder Retreat will take place at Hidden Valley Institute of the Arts in Carmel Valley, California. Just inland from Carmel by the Sea, Carmel Valley is a quiet village surrounded by wooded hillsides. Hidden Valley Music Seminars hosts all sorts of music workshops. Its secluded grounds include a dormitory wing with small but comfortable rooms for two, each with its own bathroom. Meals are served in the adjacent dining hall, and classes take place in various class rooms or the theater. Participants may choose between a double room with roommate (we do our utmost to match people well) or a single room (same size room - no roommate). Availability of single rooms is limited. While the schedule of classes will be intense, there will also be time for hiking and enjoying the surroundings.

Process and Application

Step 1. Rate your playing and musicianship using the Berlin / Blaker Self-Rating Chart (see our website, www.tbiaduo.com)

Step 2. Fill out the application on the reverse, including your current rating scores. *(Please note that these scores are not a judgment, but a measuring tool to help you work on your music in a focused and recording manner.)*

Step 3. Send the application with your deposit* check for \$200 to Frances Blaker, 806 Washington Ave., Albany CA 94706 (make check out to Frances Blaker / Letitia Berlin). Remainder of tuition and room and board payment is due December 15th, 2015.

Method of Acceptance: We will compare applications received by December 10th and choose the sixteen best-matched applicants who have compatible areas of interest.

Tuition and Room and Board: Tuition: \$350

Room and Board: Double room - \$310; Single room - \$390

Please note that in order to cover the cost of our venue with a limited enrollment we cannot accept commuters to this program. If you want to commute you can sign up for the retreat but must still pay tuition and the double room fee.

Arrival and Departure Times:

Check-in will be Wednesday February 24, 12:00 to 1:30 pm (first class at 2:00 pm). Classes end Sunday at 12 pm. Student performance and party on Saturday evening.

Room check-out is 10:00 am, Sunday, February 28.
