COVID-19 PROTOCOL

We hope to avoid having our workshop become a spreader of COVID, colds or flu, so, in the interests of all our participants and faculty members, we ask that you read and follow the policy stated below.

All participants and faculty for the Winds and Waves Workshop must:

- Be fully vaccinated: 2 doses of Pfizer or Moderna and at least one booster (preferably the bivalent booster), unless you have had COVID in the three months before the workshop. If your doctor has advised you not to get the booster please let us know.
- Prepare to rapid test the day before, and the first day of the workshop.
- Bring N-95 or KN-95 masks. Masking is recommended while indoors when not playing.

In the week before the workshop we ask that you do your best to avoid contact with people known to you to have COVID or other infectious diseases, including the common cold, and to mask when being indoors around other people unknown to you, or people known to you who have COVID, or a cold, or other illnesses that can be spread through aerosols. If, despite these precautions you are experiencing any of the following symptoms we will ask you to cancel your participation and will credit your payment toward a future Tibia Adventures in Music workshop: cough that is not a chronic cough or one caused by allergies, shortness of breath, or difficulty breathing; fever or chills; muscle or body aches; vomiting or diarrhea; new loss of taste or smell.

If you develop a cold during the workshop but test negative for COVID we will ask you to keep your mask on and observe classes, or, if the room is very large, you may play while maintaining a distance of at least 15 feet from the other participants. If you test positive for COVID during the workshop we will ask you to leave the workshop.
