COVID-19 PROTOCOL

All participants and faculty for the Winds and Waves Workshop must:

- Take rapid tests for COVID the day before, and first morning of the workshop. Bring extra tests in case someone tests positive during the weekend. If you have had close contact with an infected individual before or during the workshop, test every day regardless of symptoms.
- Bring N-95 or KN-95 masks. Masking is recommended while indoors when not playing, and in the week prior to the workshop when indoors in public places, when using public transportation, and when socializing with someone who is sick.

We strongly recommend that you be fully vaccinated with the most recent vaccine unless you have had COVID in the three months before the workshop. If, despite these precautions you test positive for COVID we will ask you to cancel your participation and will credit 75% of your payment toward a future Tibia Adventures in Music workshop.

If you develop a cold during the workshop but test negative for COVID we will ask you to keep your mask on and observe classes, or, if the room is very large, you may play while maintaining a distance of at least 15 feet from the other participants. If you test positive for COVID during the workshop, we will ask you to leave the workshop.
